Secondments at national and international organisations

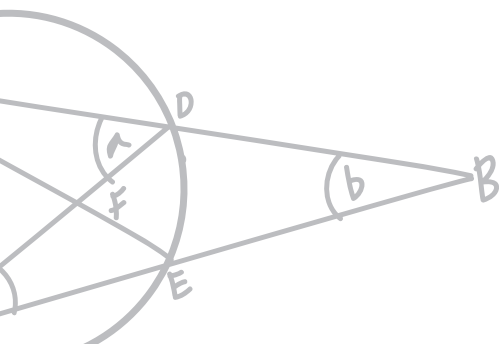
